CURRICULUM:

During the fall semester students learn **HTML, CSS and Bootstrap** and complete a final web development group project. During the spring semester students choose to pursue one of the following tech tracks: **Advanced Web Development, Product Management, UX Design, Digital Marketing, or Data Science.**

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Tech Flex Leaders (TFL) Program is an immersive out-of-school time program for juniors and seniors enrolled in a Los Angeles high school. This program engages students interested in technology through:

- Weekly technical training sessions led by industry experts
- Intersectional professional development sessions
- Career days and mentorship opportunities with representatives from leading technology companies
- Paid summer internships and job opportunities through the AOT employer partner network

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for the 2024 - 2025 program must:

- Be a rising junior or senior enrolled in an LA County public or public charter high school
- Be interested in careers in computer science / technology
- Be available for virtual sessions once a week, Monday-Thursday from 4:30 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. during the 2024 - 2025 school year
- Be available to attend in-person sessions three (3) times a semester

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible to apply?

- Rising high school juniors and seniors currently attending an LA County public or public charter high school are eligible to apply. Graduating high school seniors (Class of '24) would not be eligible to participate in the program.
- *Note: AOT prioritizes candidates who:*
 - Self-identify as Hispanic / Latinx
 - Self-identify as African American / Black
 - Self-identify as females and/or girls and/or non-binary
 - Self-identify as LGBTQIA+
 - Attend an LA County high school that meets our Economic Needs Index

Do I have to live in Los Angeles?

- Yes. To be eligible to participate in the Tech Flex Leaders program you must be a resident of Los Angeles County.

Is the program virtual?

- It is hybrid! Most technical sessions take place via Zoom. You can ONLY participate in the program if you are able to attend sessions in-person three (3) times a semester. In-person sessions will take place in Downtown Los Angeles.

When will I find out if I am accepted?

- Application decisions will go out late August. Students who are accepted must submit their confirmation form and parent/guardian consent packet to reserve their space in the program.

Do I need previous coding experience?

- Nope. No prior experience is required - just the desire to learn!

Do I have to pay for this program?

- The Tech Flex Leaders Program is completely free! In fact, students who successfully complete the program will earn a **\$1,000 stipend**.

Do I have to attend every program session?

- In order to be able to really learn the material, it is important that you are present for all sessions. Students who cannot commit to the full program should not apply.

What kind of technology do I need to participate?

- In order to participate fully you'll need a laptop and/or desktop computer and a stable internet connection with video capability! Don't have those? Don't worry! Let us know in your application.
